Associate of Applied Science to Bachelor of Science in Interior Design

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Olivet Nazarene University (ONU) for the Interior Design degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. Olivet Nazarene University Graduation Requirements

- Minimum credit hours required for BS in Interior Design: 120 credit hours
- A minimum grade point average of 2.0 (“C”) required.
- A minimum *institutional* grade point average of 2.0 required.
- A minimum of 30 hours of credit in upper-division courses (numbered 300 or above) for bachelor’s degrees
- Completion of a major program of study as specified by the College, School, or Department to which the major belongs including:
 - All general Education courses
 - All major and supporting courses
- Lower-level courses may cover the same material as the ONU equivalent, but is taught at a lower level. It cannot be used to satisfy the Olivet requirement of 30 upper division hours (300-400 level courses).
