



MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

STANDARDS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Recipients will be selected through live auditions.</li> <li>2. Recipients of a voice, piano, or instrumental scholarship will be awarded regardless of major for their freshman year only.</li> <li>3. Recipients must participate in at least one ensemble for each area in which an award is given. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Voice</i>: Concert Singers, Orpheus Choir, Show Choir, Gospel Choir, Apollo Choir</li> <li>• <i>Instrumental</i>: Concert Band, Jazz Band, Marching Band, University Orchestra, Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band</li> <li>• <i>Keyboard</i>: may serve as accompanists</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
RENEWAL	<p>Renewal is dependent on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student must maintain an overall grade point average of 2.75 (based on 4.0).</li> <li>• Student must maintain an overall grade point average of 3.2 in music courses.</li> <li>• Student must maintain an appropriate performance level.</li> <li>• Student must continue to <u>major</u> in music.</li> </ul>
AUDITIONS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Each student will be heard by a committee of faculty members.</li> <li>2. Since live auditions provide the committee with more information, it is in the best interest of the student audition in person rather than submit a recorded performance.</li> <li>3. Repertoire: <u>Literature used at State Solo and Ensemble contest would be appropriate for this audition.</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Voice</i>: two contrasting songs, memorization recommended (foreign language is NOT necessary. If you are not proficient singing in a foreign language, sing in English)</li> <li>• <i>Instrumental</i>: two classical solo pieces of contrasting style from standard literature</li> <li>• <i>Keyboard</i>: two classical solo selections of contrasting styles, memorization recommended</li> <li>• <i>Theory/Composition</i>: examples of original compositions, hand-written or computer generated. Performance of the work recorded on a CD is helpful. Students should also prepare to audition with a prepared piece for voice, piano, or instrument.</li> <li>• Sight reading will be included for ALL instrumental applicants.</li> <li>• A basic theory and musicianship examination will be given to ALL applicants.</li> <li>• A piano placement examination will be given to ALL applicants.</li> </ul> </li> <li>4. The School of Music will not be responsible for supplying an accompanist for instrumental auditions. Please have your accompanist attend the audition with you or prepare your piece without accompaniment. A staff accompanist will be available for vocal auditions. <i>No pre-recorded accompaniments.</i></li> </ol>
ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS	<p>We will need the following information to complete the audition process.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A list of all high school and church music activities, high school honors, citation or musical achievements is to be brought with you and turned in on your audition date.</li> <li>• Two letters of recommendation should be sent to the attention of <i>Dr. Don Reddick, Dean, School of Music, ONU Box 6044, One University Avenue, Bourbonnais, IL 60914.</i> The letters should be sent by qualified musicians such as your high school band/choir/orchestra director, private teacher, or others who are familiar with your abilities.</li> </ul>

## University Orchestra Scholarship

String instrument (only) players who are new participants in the Olivet orchestra will receive a scholarship for each full year they are in the orchestra.

Orchestra members *are required to audition* for Dr. Woodruff each year.

All string instrument scholarship recipients are required to enroll in private lessons at Olivet Nazarene University.

## ONU Marching Tigers/Concert Band Scholarship

Each new student joining the Olivet Marching, Concert/Pep Band will receive a scholarship for a full year of participation in the ONU Band Program. The scholarship covers two parts of the Band Program - marching band/color guard portion (Fall) and concert/pep band portion (Spring).

Currently, there is *no audition required* for participation in the ONYU Marching Tigers Band Program.
