

## Facilities and Services Available to Students with Disabilities

The Office of Learning Support Services at Olivet Nazarene University is dedicated to supporting the University’s efforts toward accessibility and inclusion for students with disabilities. This is accomplished through collaboration, advocacy, education, and accommodation. The Office of Learning Support Services works with students on an individual, case-by-case basis determining appropriate, reasonable accommodations to promote the student’s learning, growth, development, and success. All students admitted to the University are ensured both building and program access. Such access is provided through a variety of services and facilities. The following chart provides an overview of accommodations provided by the University. Other accommodations may also be provided beyond those listed in the chart based on student need. Accommodations are determined on a case-by-case basis.
