

Student Right-to-Know Act Graduation Rate Report
Olivet Nazarene University

Olivet Nazarene University is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990. The rates reflect the graduation/completion status of our Fall 2015 cohort of first-time, full-time, degree seeking undergraduates for whom graduated within 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed. Sports graduation rates include only students who received athletic financial aid.

During the fall semester of 2015, 731 first-time, full-time, degree-seeking Undergraduate students entered Olivet Nazarene University. After 6 years, as of August 31, 2021, 64% of these students had graduated from our institution to complete a bachelor's degree.

While reviewing this information, please bear in mind:

- The graduation/completion rate is based on 6 years of attendance that equates to 150% of our longest program.
- We have elected not to report our transfer-out rate because our university's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.
- The graduation/completion rate does not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government. Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
- These charts do not identify the reasons why our students withdrew; therefore, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
- A pound sign (#) denotes any cohort/subcohort with five or fewer students. The university is not permitted to disclose this information in order to protect student privacy.
