

Applying to Olivet

STEP 1: Fill out the online [application](#) to begin the application process to Olivet Nazarene University.

STEP 2: Mail the necessary documentation items to Olivet or email Dswanso2@olivet.edu

- ACT/SAT score
- Send official transcripts from high school or college (international transcripts must be sent to evaluation company, such as [ECE](#), [WES](#), or [INCRED](#) (**Note: INCRED required for NAIA for athletes)
- Two (2) [recommendation forms](#)
- Send a copy of passport with picture and information page
- Transfer students in US send copy of visa, current I-20 and transfer form from DSO
- Evidence of English language proficiency; Results of the [TOEFL](#) (Test of English as a Foreign Language): Paper Based Test=550, Computer Based Test=213, Internet Based
 - Test=70, Completion of Level 109 at ELS Language Centers
- Statement of Faith
- Supporting financial documents: Official bank statement from person paying for schooling showing the amount of one year's tuition and fees total, with bank official's signature and notarized.
- Affidavit signed and notarized by owner of the bank statement

STEP 3:

- Once all documents have been received, you will be admitted, and your letter of acceptance and I-20 will be sent to you
- Please create shipping label for I-20 to be sent. [eShipGlobal](#)
- Pay your SEVIS I-901 fee
- Contact US Embassy or Consulate to for visa appointment
- You may email all documents to International Student Services office Dswanso2@olivet.edu, however bring official documents to visa appointment and to ISS office upon arrival
