

**Olivet Nazarene University  
 Student Right-to-Know Act  
 Graduation Rate Report**

Olivet Nazarene University is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation/completion status of first-time freshman students who enrolled during the (2002-03) school year and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed. Sports graduation rates include only students who received athletic financial aid.

During the fall semester of 2002, 553 first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking Undergraduate students entered Olivet Nazarene University. After 6 years, as of August 31, 2008, 60% of these students had graduated from our institution or completed a bachelor's degree.

While reviewing this information, please bear in mind:

- The graduation/completion rate is based on 6 years of attendance that equates to 150% of our longest program.
- We have elected not to report our transfer-out rate because our university's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in other institutions.
- The graduation/completion rate does not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government. Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
