SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Olivet Nazarene University is a proud member of the Early Childhood Consortium for Equity (ECACE). The ECACE scholarship program was created to address the shortage of qualified early childhood professionals in the State of Illinois. The scholarship funds will cover the cost of attendance after other financial aid has been applied.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen
- Have submitted a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FASFA)
- Be currently working or have worked in the early childhood field
- Be a current member in the Gateways to Opportunity® Registry
- Be enrolled at Olivet Nazarene University in one of the following:
 - Early Childhood Education Degree Program
 - Child Development Degree Program
