<u>In addition</u> to sending specific athletic forms & physicals to your coach/trainer, ALL athletes must follow this procedure for additional health form document submission required by Olivet Counseling & Health Services.

For the safety of our campus community, <u>all students</u> are required to have specific up-to-date immunizations <u>and</u> a physical exam before arriving on campus. All new students must verify their immunization and medical history through the Med+Proctor system. **You must have a valid Olivet Nazarene University email address before registering on Med+Proctor.** Check your personal email for instructions for accessing your Olivet email.

- 1. After submitting your deposit to attend Olivet Nazarene University, you will receive instructions via your personal email address for accessing your @olivet.edu email address.
- 2. Register for your new lifetime account with Med+Proctor by visiting http://www.medproctor.com
- 3. Click on "Register for a new account" and use your Olivet Nazarene University email address.
- 4. Complete your Olivet Med+Proctor profile.
- 5. Download & print your Olivet Med+Proctor Immunization Certificate & Physical form.
- 6. Have your medical provider complete your physical and immunization certificate.
- Upload an image of your physical exam and immunization certificate into your Med+Proctor account.
