The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree from MVCC and a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree in Criminal Justice (General Concentration) from ONU.

Olivet Nazarene University Graduation Requirements

Minimum credit hours required for BS in Criminal Justice: 120 credit hours





- A minimum grade point average of 2.0 ("C") required.
- A minimum institutional grade point average of 2.0 required.
- A minimum of grade point average of 2.0 required for general concentration classes.
- A minimum of 30 hours of credit in upper-division courses (numbered 300 or above) for bachelor's degrees. Even though MVCC classes transfer in as upper division classes, those classes do not count towards the upper division requirement of 30 hours for graduation.
- Completion of a major program of study as specified by the College, School, or Department to which the major belongs including:
 - All general Education courses
 - All major and supporting courses
- Lower-level courses may cover the same material as the ONU equivalent, but is taught at a lower level. It cannot be used to satisfy the Olivet requirement of 30 upper division hours (300-400 level courses).
