
Earn up to 36 credit hours annually, at a cost of \$10,000 per year. And Financial Aid is available.

# **ACADEMIC PROGRAMS**

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### THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B.S.) IN BUSINESS

is a program designed to expose students to the qualitative and quantitative aspects of business, including human resources, information technology, finance, economics, and marketing. The program focuses on the integration of real-life experience into the academic coursework to apply critical thinking skills to identify, analyze, and solve business-related problems from a Christian worldview.

THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B.S.) IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRY interweaves an academic and practical education for ministry, preparing students to serve God and people in the setting of today's Church. This program provides entry-level knowledge and skills in the areas of biblical studies, theology, philosophy, and the history of Christianity, as well as practices such as Christian education and spiritual formation.

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THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B.S.) IN CHILD DEVELOPMENT is designed for the student who wants to work with children outside of a classroom setting. Child development offers a holistic approach to child studies - focusing on a child's physical, emotional, social, and intellectual development. At Olivet, students will plan and design activities for young children and learn how to identify emotional or developmental problems.

THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B.S.) IN COMPUTER SCIENCE is designed so that students will have a foundation in a wide range of disciplines in the Computer Science and Emerging Technologies (CSET) field. Students will take CSET core courses intermixing them with courses specific to their concentration. CSET offers three concentrations to choose from in the B.S. in Computer Science program: Software Development, Software Entrepreneurship, and Network & Data Communications.

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## THE BACHELOR OF ARTS (B.A.) IN COMPUTING

TECHNOLOGY is tailored to each students interests in the field of computer science. The Computer Science Core classes will give you all of the information you need to get started and advanced classes allow you to gain further experience in different areas. This degree is helpful for those who may not be seeking technical knowledge, but rather a broader and more general understanding of the entire field. Whether you are going into the business world, or looking to move into an IT specialty, you will have the skills to excel wherever you decide to go.

THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B.S.) IN CYBERSECURITY prepares students for in-demand, global positions in education, military, healthcare, criminal justice, or business. This program focuses on developing the technical competence needed to fill the growing number of positions across the world. By taking several additional network-specific courses, students may earn a double major in Computer Science and Cybersecurity.

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THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B.S.) IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION is a program suited for those with a heart for teaching young children. This degree will prepare students for the Illinois Early Childhood Professional Educator License / ESL endorsement. At Olivet, early childhood education majors have opportunities in and outside the classroom to learn and grow in their field. These students will study instructional methods, children's literature, language development, and sociology of the family, as well as learn about the philosophies of early childhood education.

THE ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE (A.S.) IN BUSINESS is a program designed to challenge students to learn the foundational aspects of business, equipping them for entry level positions within the business world OR as preparation for continuing to earn a bachelor's degree in business from a Christian worldview.

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Students can complete two years of pre-major coursework at an ONUPlus Extension Site, then complete years 3 and 4 on the main campus in Bourbonnais, Illinois, leading to Bachelor of Science degrees in these majors.
