"I had spent four years with my special ed students and had served them in every way," she says. "It was not an easy decision to uproot the family and make the move to Illinois. Keeping Christ at the center and taking one day at a time are important priorities for Crystal. She strives to focus on the right here, right now, today. "I'm amazed each day by how I am now a part of the continuation of ONU," she says.
